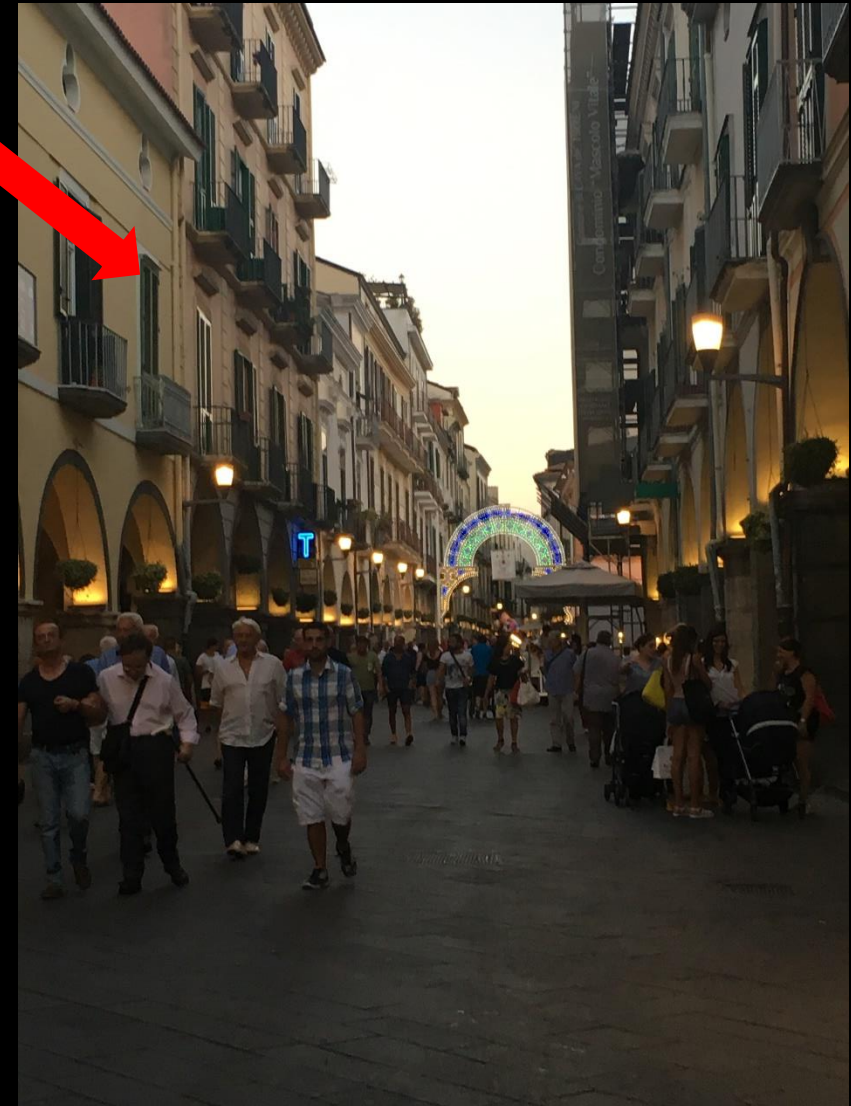

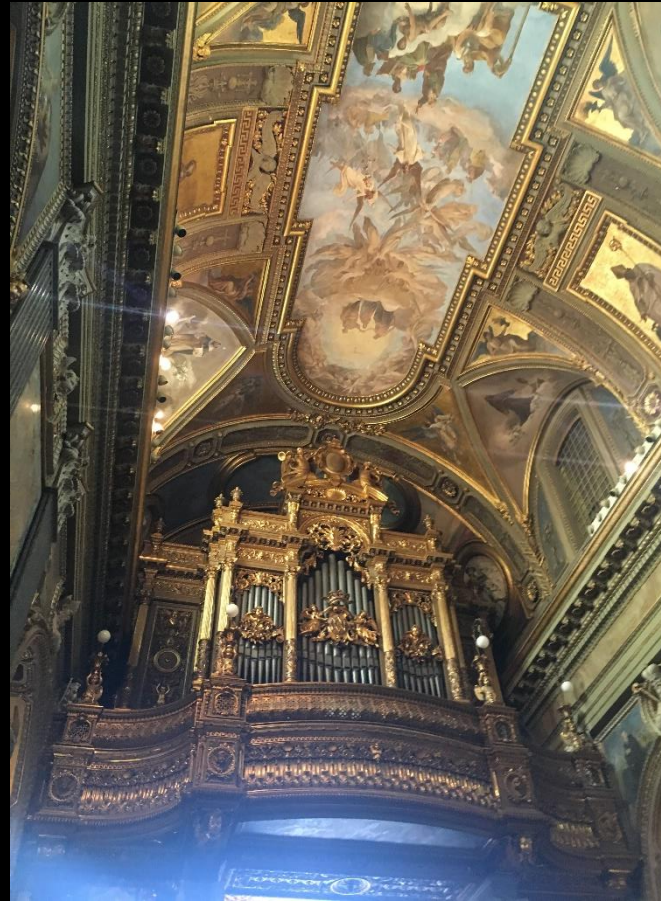
BUILDINGSIGHT IN POMPEI:

Then Gianna showed us some interesting places very close to Cava.



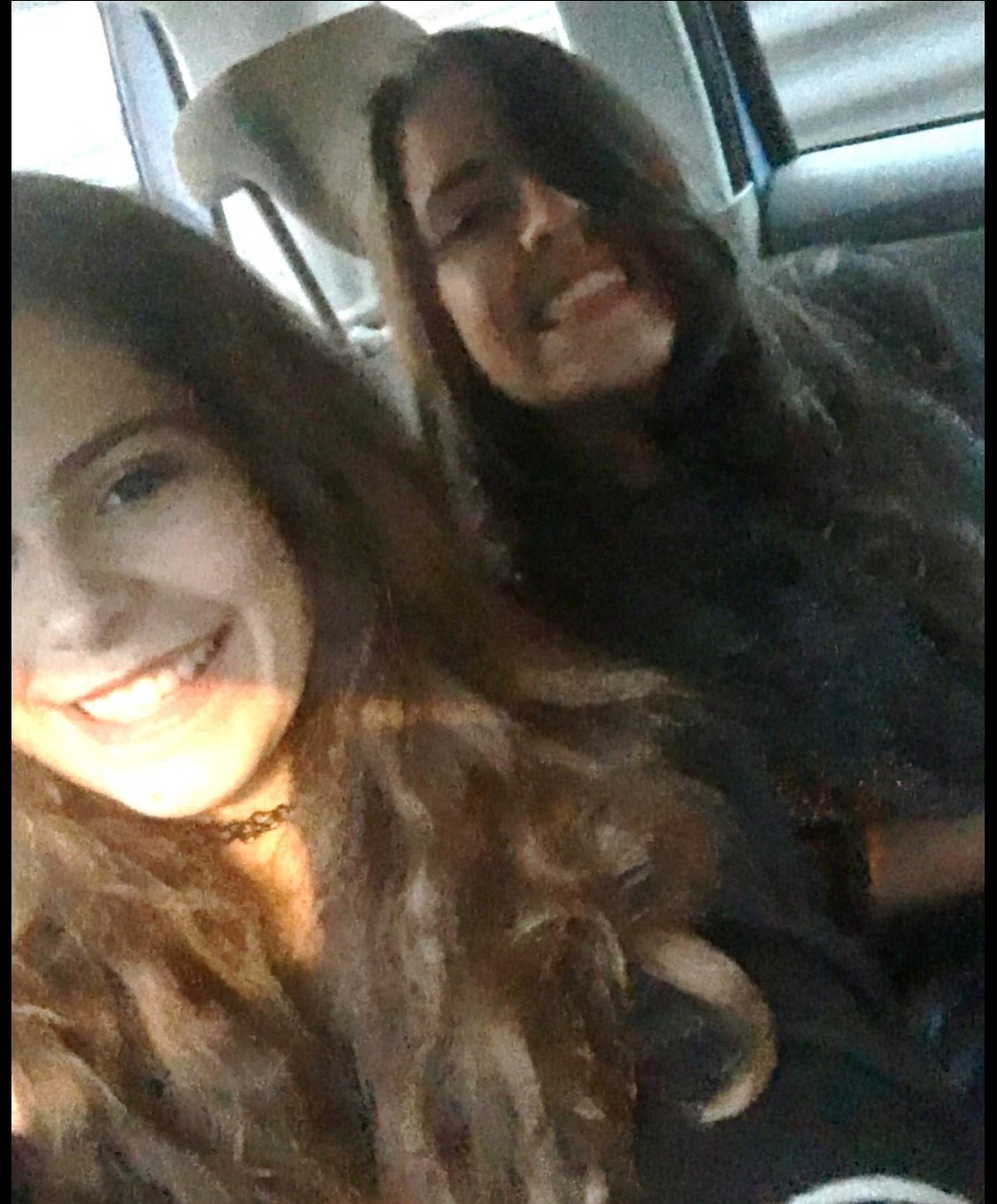
L'ABBAZIA BENEDETTINA

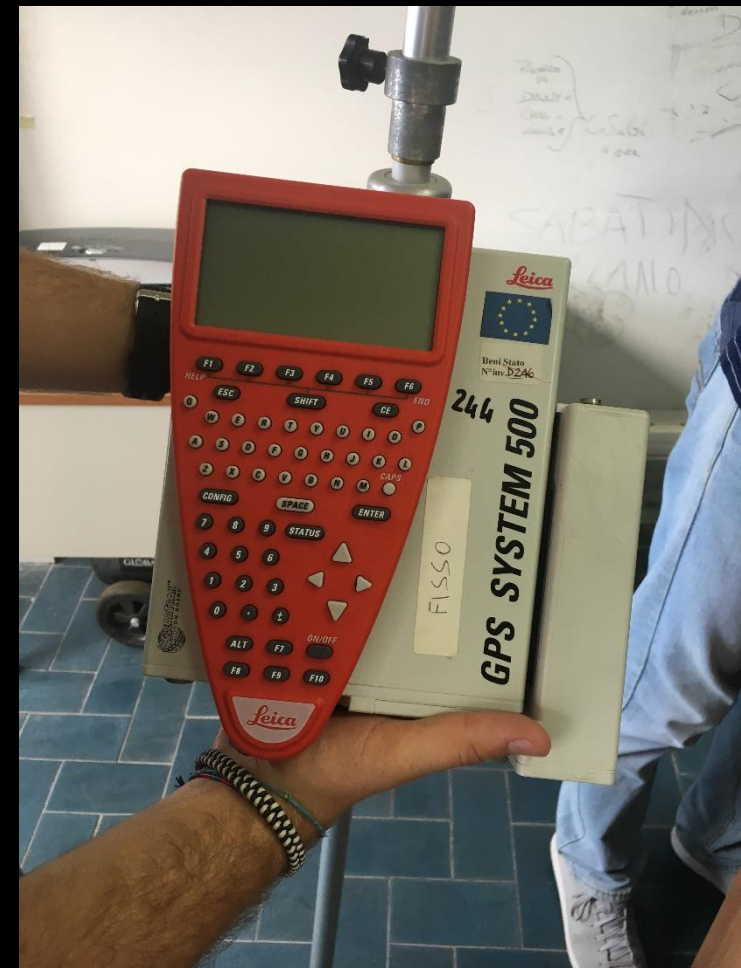

SCHOOL INSTRUMENTS

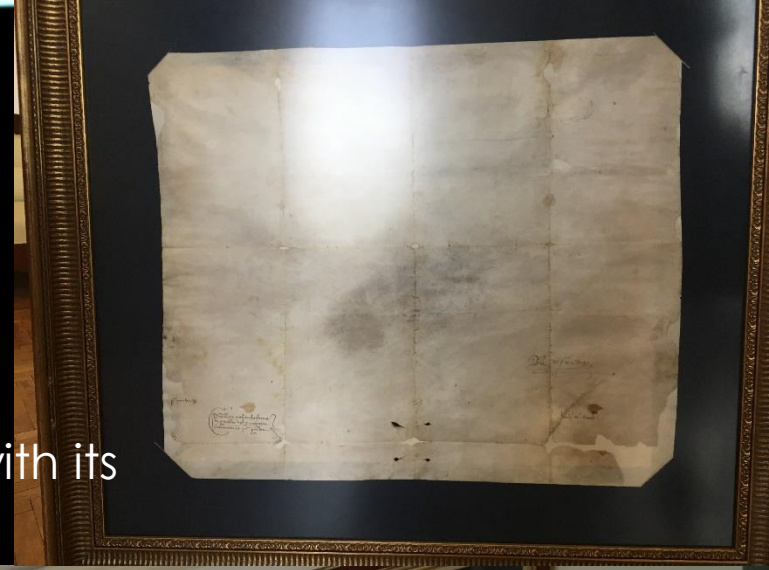


Some instruments the students use at school to get experiences.

We even were allowed to see the room of the major.

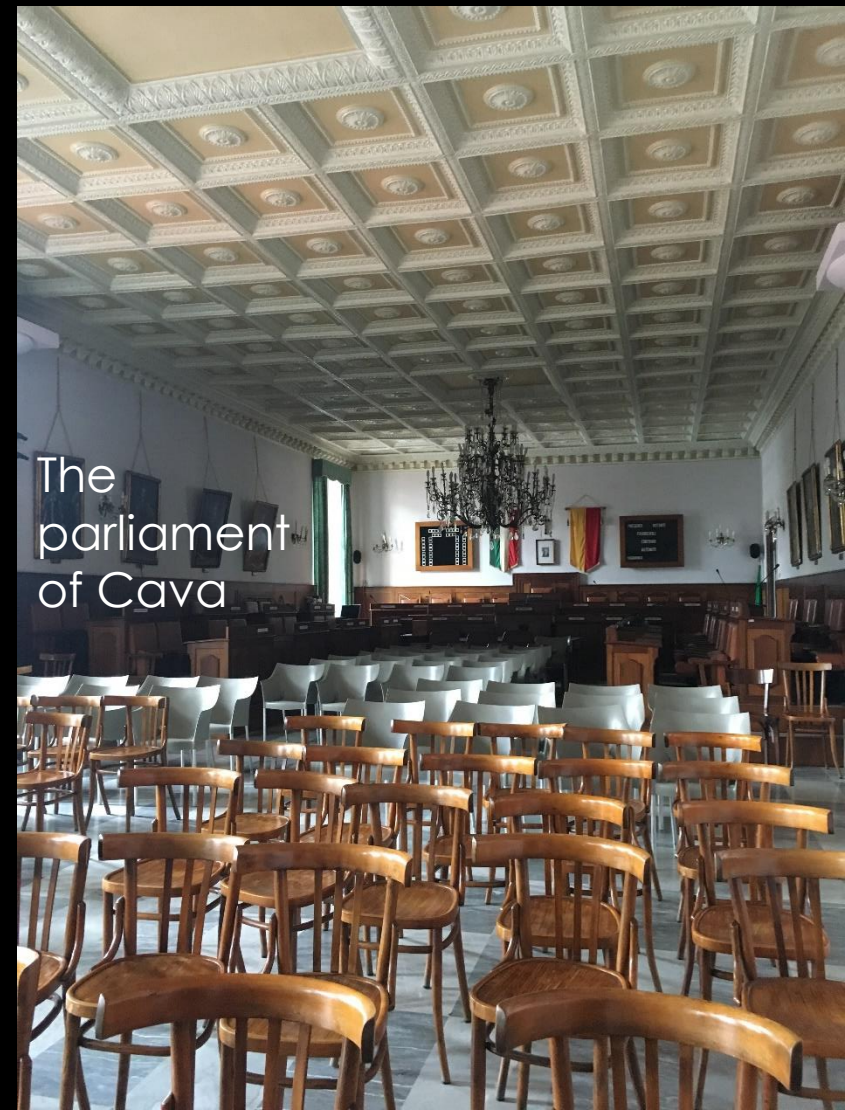
